PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACTS 1903-1904.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that on account of urgency the following Regulations under the Defence Acts 1903-1904 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulations to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations.

REGULATIONS FOR THE COMMONWEALTH MILITARY CADET CORPS.

Amendments.

Four Battalions in New South Wales.

One and a half Battalions in Queensland.

One Battalion in Western Australia.

Half Battalion, with Band, in Tasmania.

Regulation 13 of Section 2, as amended by Statutory Rule No. 121, dated 6th December, 1907, is cancelled, and the following substituted therefor:—

13. The number of Battalions to be maintained in each District shall be—

Victoria	11
Queensland	6
South Australia	5
Western Australia	4
Tasmania	2
Total	41

Battalions shall be arranged topographically.
