PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACTS 1903-1904.

I THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that on account of urgency the following Regulations under the Defence Acts 1903-1904 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulations to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations.

AMENDMENT.

After Regulation 87 *add*—

"87A. The sum of rs. per day shall be withheld from soldiers of the Royal Australian Artillery during the first three months of service, and shall be payable as arrears after the expiration of the said three months if the soldier is still serving. Soldiers who are discharged or have deserted prior to the completion of three months' service shall forfeit such arrears."
