PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACTS 1903-1904.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, on account of urgency, the following Regulation under the Defence Acts 1903-1904 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulation to come into operation forthwith as a Provisional Regulation.

REGULATIONS (PROVISIONAL) FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Addition.

At end of Regulation 485, add new sub-paragraph:—

A member of the Permanent Forces absent from duty for more than 42 days in any one year, on account of illness the result of misconduct, shall be discharged as medically unfit.
