PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1912.

REGULATIONS (PROVISIONAL) FOR THE COMMONWEALTH MILITARY FORCES.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, on account of urgency, the following Regulation under the *Defence Act 1903-1912* should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulation to come into operation forthwith as a Provisional Regulation.
