PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1912.

AMENDMENT TO C.M. REGULATION 71.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, on account of urgency, the following Regulation under the *Defence Act* 1903-1912 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulation to come into operation forthwith as a Provisional Regulation.

REGULATIONS (PROVISIONAL) FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

AMENDMENT.

At end of Regulation 71, add the following new Regulation:—

71A. Except under special circumstances approved by the Minister, an officer on first appointment to the Royal Australian Garrison Artillery will be posted to the District in which the Company in which the vacancy exists is located, but he will be allotted for duty during his probationary period to the Royal Australian Garrison Artillery in the 2nd Military District, and Sydney will be regarded as the place at which he first takes up his permanent appointment.

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
