Regulation 106c.-Regulation 106c is cancelled, and the following substituted therefor:-

"rocc. An officer of the Citizen Forces or Senior Cadlets who has passed in any of the subjects contained in the syllabus of the military examination for transfer and first appointment to a commission in the Pormanent Forces will, for a period of five years from the date of such examination, be exempt from examination in such subjects for the rank of lieutenant or captain in the Citizen Forces."
