REGULATIONS (PROVISIONAL) FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF THE COMMON-WEALTH.—REGULATIONS 475 AND 4754—AMERICANTS.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of a Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, an account of urgency, the following Regulations under the Defence Act 1903-1912 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulations to come into appreciation forthwith as Provisional Regulations.
