PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1912.

REGULATIONS (PROVISIONAL) FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF THE COMMON-
WEALTH.—REGULATIONS 475 AND 475A—AMENDMENTS.

I THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of
Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council,
hereby certify that, on account of urgency, the following Regula-
tions under the *Defence Act* 1903-1912 should come into immediate
operation, and make the Regulations to come into operation forthwith
as Provisional Regulations.

REGULATIONS (PROVISIONAL) FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Amendments.

Regulation 475—The amendment promulgated by Statutory Rule
