PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1912. 17/5/19

REGULATIONS FOR THE ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE OF AUSTRALIA— REGULATION 78—AMENDMENT.

I THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that on account of urgency the following Regulation under the *Defence Act* 1903-1912 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulation to come into operation forthwith as a Provisional Regulation.

REGULATIONS FOR THE ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE OF AUSTRALIA.

Amendment.

At end of Regulation 78, after sub-paragraph (iii.), *add*—

“(iv.). The value of any stores or other property lost or damaged, either wilfully or by neglect, may be stopped from the wages of any employé.”
