## REGULATIONS FOR THE ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE OF AUSTRALIA-REGULATIONS 35 AND 37-AMENDMENTH.

THE GOVERNOR GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Coun-cil, hereby certify that on account of urgency the following Regulations under the Defence Act 1903-1912 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulations to come into operation forllswith as Provisional Regulations.

REQUIATIONS FOR THE ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE OF AUSTRALIA.

Amendments.

Regulation 35,---At end of sub-paragraph (c) add :---"but it is not intended to meet the cost of dontat or medical operations and attendance by Civil Practitionergy incurred by a Codet while rusticated or absent on leave or sick leave, nor will such charges be admissible ageitat the nublic." the public."

Regulation 37 is amended to read as follows:---

- 14 37. (i.) If a Cadel is absout from the Callege ewing to sick-ness during o portion of the term, this allowance shall continue to he issued and credited to his account, oxeept is the case of Cadets who are:--
  - (a) discharged as medically unfit while on sick leave ac at the termination of sick leave;
  - (b) not advanced to a higher class through abseace due to mekness or other cause.
  - (ii.) The daily allowance will not be paid to a Cadot for any period of absence :---
    - (a) on leave or sick leave, during which he dies ar resigna
      - (b) due to elekness between the termination of his leave and dato of rejoining the College."
