PROVISIONAL REGULATION UNDER THE WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1905.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, on account of urgency, the undermentioned amended Regulation under the *Wireless Telegraphy Act 1905*, namely:—

should come into immediate operation, and make the amended Regulation to come into operation forthwith as a Provisional Regulation.

WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY REGULATIONS.

Fees for Licences.

Regulation 7 under this head (Statutory Rules 1911, No. 216) is repealed, and the following Regulation is inserted in its stead:—

7. The fees for licences shall be as follows:—

For a General Licence for ship stations or for any renewal thereof—Five shillings for each ship included in the licence.

For a Supplementary Licence for ship stations or for any renewal thereof—Five shillings for each ship included in the licence.

For an Experimental Licence for land stations—Twenty-one shillings for each year or part of a year the licence is in force.
