WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY REQUIATIONS.

Pees for Licences.

Regulation 7 under this head (Statutory Rules 1911, No. 216) is repealed, and the following Regulation is inserted in its stead;—

7. The fees for licences shall be as follows:-

For a General Liceace for ship stations or for any renewal thereof—Five shillings for each ship included in the liceace.

For a Supplementary Licence for ship stations or for any renewal thereof.—Five shillings for each ship included in the licence.

For an Experimental Licence for land stations—Twentyone shillings for each year or part of a year the licence is in force.
