PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1912.

REGULATIONS (PROVISIONAL) FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH-REGULATION 114A-AMENDMENT.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth in Australia, acting with the advise of the Federal Executive Council, horsely cartify tinta, un account of urgancy, the following Regulation under the Defence Act 1903-1912 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulation to come into operation forthwith or a Provisional Regulation.
