PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT

AMENDUENT TO COMMONWEALTH MILITARY REQULATION 544.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of A Australia, acting with the advise of the Federal Executive Council, hereby certify that, on account of urgency, the following Regulation under the Defence Act 1903-1912 should come into immediate operation, and make the Regulation to come into operation forthwith as a Previsional Regulation.
