BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

- (3.) This Act shall continue in force during the continuance of the war and for six months thereafter, and no longer.

- 3. This Act shall be deemed to have been in force from the date commencement of the commencement of the Crimes Act 1914.
