REGULATION UNDER THE LAND TAX ASSESSMENT ACT 1910-1914

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation, under the Land Tax Assessment .let 1910-1914, to come into operation forthwith. Such Regulation shall supersede the Provisional Regulation (Statutory Rules 1915, No. 22) under the said Act, unde on the 18th day of February, One thousand nine hundred and fifteen.

The Land Tax Regulations 1912 (Statutory Rules 1912, No. 141) are amended as fellow :--

By inserting therein after Regulation 45 the following Regulation:-WITNESSES' EXPENSES.

45A .- The scale of expenses to be allowed te persons required to attend and give evidence under scetion 65 of the Act shall be as fellows :-
