WAR PRECAUTIONS REGULATIONS 1915-REGULATION 590-ADDITION.

After Regulation 59s insert the following new Regulation:-

50c. In any proceedings in respect of the printing or publication protest of nny printed matter, any statement printed on the paper containing such matter as to the name of the printer or publisher of such matter shall be deemed to be sufficient proof of the name of the printer or publisher as the easo may be.
