## REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1916.

FINANCIAL AND ALLOWANCE REGULATIONS FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH—REGULATIONS 5, 78, 99, AND 231—  
AMENDMENTS.

**I** THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of  
Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council,  
hereby certify that the following Regulations under the *Defence Act*  
1903-1916 shall come into immediate operation.

## FINANCIAL AND ALLOWANCE REGULATIONS FOR THE MILITARY FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

### *Amendments.*

At the end of Regulation 5 (*f*) add the following:—

" Provided that during the period of the war, the District Com-  
mandant is authorized to provisionally approve of the writing off of  
stores up to the value of £20; but a list of all such cases in which  
the amount struck off exceeds £5 shall be submitted to Head-  
quarters after the close of each month for covering approval."

Regulation 78—Sub-paragraph (*a*)—

*Pay of Warrant Officers, Non-commissioned Officers, and Men.*

Under the heading, " Company Sergeant-Major," and between " In-  
structor " and " Engineer Clerk " insert " Assistant Military Foreman  
of Works."

Under the heading " Sergeant," and immediately following the ap-  
pointment of " Military Mechanist Electrician," insert " Assistant Military  
Foreman of Works."

(The above amendments shall be taken to have effect on and from the  
1st day of May, 1916.)

Regulation 99. *After* " Staff Officer to the Inspector-General, £50  
per annum," insert " Inspecting Ordnance Officer, £50 per annum."  
*Delete* " Inspecting Ordnance Officer, £25 per annum."

(This amendment to Regulation 99 shall be taken to have effect on  
and from the first day of July, 1916.)

Regulation 231.—That portion which reads:—

"provided that, during the period of the present war, Warrant and Non-commissioned Officers of the Instructional Staff, may, in lieu of the foregoing, be granted an allowance of 1s. 6d. per diem, such allowance to be paid to the individuals concerned."

is cancelled, and the following substituted therefor:—

"provided that during the period of the present war, Warrant and Non-commissioned Officers of the Permanent Military Force who are employed on instructional duties at A.I.F. Camps may, in lieu of the foregoing be granted an allowance of 1s. 6d. per diem, such allowance to be paid to the individuals concerned."

(This amendment to Regulation 231 shall be taken to have effect on and from the first day of December, 1915.)
