COMMITTEE OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS.

No. 27 of 1917.

An Act to provide for the Appointment of the Joint Committee of Public Accounts during the Second Session of the Seventh Parliament of the Commonwealth.

[Assented to 21st September, 1917.]

E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Committee of Public Accounts Act 1917.

Appointment of Committee during Seventh Parliament

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section two of the Committee of Public Accounts Act 1913, the Joint Committee of Public Accounts to be appointed during the Seventh Parliament of commonwealth. the Commonwealth, may be appointed during the second session of that Parliament, and shall be appointed as soon as practicable after the commencement of this Act.
