THE WAR PRECAUTIONS (ALIENS REGISTRATION) REQULATIONS 1916. Amendments.

I THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commanwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Exceutive Council, hereby make the following Regulations mider the War Precautions 1st 1914-1916 to come into operation on ond from the 1st day of July, One thousand nine hundred and seventeen.

THE WAR PRECAUTIONS (ALIENS REGISTRATION) REGULATIONS 1916.

- 1. Regulation 3 is amended by substituting the word "sixteen" for the word "fifteen" in the definition of "Align."
 - Regulation 5 is amended—
 - (a) By substituting the following for sub-regulation (2):—
 - (2) Every alien entering the Commonwealth after the 30th day of June, 1917, as a passenger in or as the master or a member of the crew of an oversca vessel shall, immediately after the arrival of the vessel at the first port of eall in the Commonwealth, unless he is exempted by or under these Regulations, register himself as an alien in accordance with these Regulations, and every alien who refuses or fails to do so, or who lands hefore he has registered, shall be guilty of an offence.
 - (b) By substituting the word "sixteen" for the word "fifteen" in sub-regulation (3).
 - 3. The following regulations are substituted for regulations 6-9:-
 - 6. (1) An alieu resident in the Commonwealth shall effect his Allenreidert a registration by properly completing a notice (in triplicate) in accord. auce with Form A1 in the Schedule to these Regulations and by emering requ-attending in person with such notices before the aliens registration indee. officer nearest to his usual place of abode.

(2) Any aften resident in the Commonwealth who, on account of absonce from his usual place of abode, is mabble before the 31st day of October, 1916, to attend before the abous registration officer nearest te his usual place of abode may attend before any otiger alions registration officer for the purpose of registering himself. - 7. (1) An alion entering the Commonwealth as a passenger in, or as the master or as a member of the erew of an evaren vessel, shall effect his registration by properly completing a active (in triplicate) in accordance with Form A2 in the Schedule to these Regulations, and by attending in person, immediately after the arrival of the vessel at the first part of call in the Commonwealth, before an alicus registration officer on board the vessel with the following documents:—
 - (a) the notice in Farm A2, in triplicate; and
 - (b) his certificate of registration (if he has been registered under these Regulations during a provious visit to the Commonwealth, and if his certificate was not taken from him on his departure from the Commonwealth); and
 - (c) his passport (if he he a passanger or a member of the crew not signed on in Australia but due for dischargè in a Commonwealth port).

Masters of vossels to assist allens registration officers.

- (2) (n) The master of every oversen vessel, other than a public vessel of any Government shall inamediately on arrivat at the first port of eall furnish to an alien registration officer or other officer acting under these Regulations a list showing the number and names of the crew, and their nationality and race, and produce the vessel's articles.
- (b) The muster of every vessel shall afford to all aftens registration officers and other officers acting under these Regulations every facility for performing their duties, and shall permit any such officer at any time to cuter the vessel and to search every part of her.
 - (c) The mester of a vessel who-
 - (i) refuses or neglects to afford all reasonable facilities to an officer for the performance of his duties; or
 - (ii) refuses or neglects on demand to deliver forthwith to an officer any list required by these Regulations; or (iii) delivers to an officer any list or statement which is because
 - (iii) delivers to an officer any list or statement which is incorrect in any material particular.

shall be guilty of an offence.

Communicating with years heloro registration has been completed. (3) Any person who, except in the excention of his duties as a public servant, boards any oversea vessel in the Commonwealth at her first port of call, or ecumunicates with any alien on board an oversea vessel of her first part of call in the Commonwealth, before the registration in accordance with these Regulations of all aliens on board has been completed, shall be guilty of an offence.

Officers may require signalure and thumb print, 7A. An aliens registration officer or other officer acting under these Regulations may require an alien (if he can write) to write his usual signature on any form or other accument, and to allow a print of his fingers and thumbs or any of them to be taken on

any form or other document; and any alien who refuses to write his signature, or writes a signature which is not his usual signature, or who refuses to allow a complete and legible print of any of his fingers and thumbs to be taken, shall be guilty of an offence.

8. Upon the registration of an alien in accordance with these less of regulations, a certificate of registration in accordance will Form registration. B1 or B2 in the Schedula to these Regulations shall be issued to him.

9. (t) An alien shall not change his place of abode unless he first alleas to report gives notice to the aliens registration officer nearest to his place of change, indeed. abede of the date on which he intends to change his place of abode, and of his inloaded new piaca of abodo.

- (2) The natice shall be given by the atien properly completing a notice (in triplicate) in accordance with Form E in the Schedule to these Regulations, and by the olien attending in person with such notices before that aliens registration officer; provided that if the alien's place of ahode is distant more than ten miles from the office of that officer it shall be sufficient if the notices be sent by post or messenger to him.
- (3) If the alien does not change his place of abode in accordance with the particulars stated in the notice, he shall forthwith inform that officer of the cancellation of his intended change of abode, or of any alteration in the intended date of his change of abodo or in his infended new place of residence, as the case may be.
- (4) An alien shall within seven days after acquiring a new place of abode atland in person before the aliens registration officer nearest to his new place of abode and shall bring with him his certificate of registration.
- (5) An alien arriving in the Commonwealth who acquires a place of abode in the Commonwealth shall within seven days ofter sequiring a place of abode give notice thereof to the aliens registration officer nearest thereto.

The notice shall be given by the alien preperly completing a notice (in triplicate) in accordance with Form E in the Schedule to these Regulations, and attending in person therewith and with his cortificate of registration before that aliens registration officer

- (6) This Regulation does not apply to an olion who (not having a place of abode in the Commonwealth) travels in the Commonwesith without acquiring a place of ahede, or who (having a place of abode in the Commonwealth) travels in the Commonwealth without changing his place of abode.
- (7) An alien who acts in contravention of any provision of this Regulation shall be guilty of an effonce.
- 4. Sub-regulation (1) of regulation 10 is amended to read as follows:---
 - 10. (1) It shall be the duty of the keeper of every hetel, inn, boardinghouse, and lodginghouse in Australia, to provide himself with a register for the purposes of this regulation, and to ascertain

and enter in such register the following particulars of all aliens staying at the hotel, inn, boardinghouse, or lodginghouse:-

- and if the keeper of an hetel, inn, beardinghouse, or ladginghouse, fails to provide himself with a register, or to ascertain and enter therein the foregoing particulars in respect of any alien staying at his premises, or if he makes any entry in any such registor which he knows, or could by the exercise of reasonable diligence have ascertained, to be false, he shall be guilty of an offence.
- 5. The following regulations are substituted for regulations 12-13:-
- 12. (1) Every alion shall, on domand made by an officer, produce to the officer forthwith his certificate of registration, and if he faits to do so, he shall be guilty of an offence.
- (2) Any person who has pessession of a certificate of registration issued to a deceased alien shall, on demand made by an officer, hand the certificate to the efficer forthwith, and if he fails to do so, he shall he guilty of an offence.
- (3) An officer may require any alien who is about to loave the Commonwealth to give up to him his certificate of registration, and if the alien fails to do so, he shall be guilty of an offence.

13. Any officer may at any time require any person believed by him to be an olion to answer any question as to his name, birthplace, nationality, place of living, movements, or business, and to produce documentary or other evidence of his nationality, and any person who refuses or fails to answer any such question or to produes any such evidence in his possession or control, or who gives a folse or misleading answer to any such question shall be guilty of an offence.
