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## REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1918.

REGULATIONS FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS IN A CIVIL CAPACITY  
IN CONNEXION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENCE.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation under the *Defence Act* 1903-1918, to come into operation forthwith.
