1920. No. 215.

REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1918.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following regulations under the *Defence Act* 1903-1918 to come into operation forthwith.

AMENDMENT OF THE WAR FINANCIAL REGULATIONS.

The War Financial Regulations are amended as follows:—

(1) That portion of regulation 54, reading as under, is cancelled as from 25th August, 1920:—

(2) Regulations 54A, 54B, and 54C are re-numbered 54b, 54c, and 54d respectively.

(3) Next after regulation 54 the following regulation is inserted, to take effect as from 25th August, 1920:—

"54A. The following shall be the rates of pay and allowances of Domestics and Wardmaids employed in Military Hospitals in Australia:—

Domestics and Wardmaids	2 0 0	When rations are issued a deduction of 7s. per week shall be made. A further deduction of 7s. per week shall be made when quarters are made available"
