WAR PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

No. 11 of 1924.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for War Pensions.

[Assented to 15th August, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the War Pensions Appropriation Short title. Act 1924.
- 2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Appropriation of £10,00,000 for war war appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of for war pensions. the Trust Account established under the Audit Act 1901-1920, and known as the War Pensions Fund, the sum of Ten million pounds for war pensions.
