COMMERCE (EXPORTS) REQUIRITIONS 1921.

(Statutory Rules 1921, No. 207, as amended to this date.)

- 1. Regulation 7 of the Commerce (Exports) Regulations 1921 is amended by inserting in paragraph (d) after the word "plants", the words "dried fruit,".
- 2. Regulation 8 of the Commerce (Exports) Regulations 1921 is amended by omitting from paragraph (j) of suh-regulation (1) thereof the sub-paragraphs (iv) and (xi).
