REGULATIONS UNDER THE NAVAL DEFENCE ACT 1910-1918.

AMENDMENT OF FLEET RESERVE REGULATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1923, No. 52, as amended to present date.)

1. Regulation 38 is amended by omitting from the second line of sub-regulation (1) the word "victualling" and inserting in its stead the word "provision."
