REGULATION UNDER THE IMMIGRATION ACT 1901-1925.

## AMENDMENT OF IMMIGRATION REGULATIONS 1913.

(Statutory Rules 1913 No. 307 as amended to this date.)

After regulation 14A of the Immigration Regulations the following heading and regulation are inserted:—

“PROCEEDINGS UNDER SECTION 8AA OR 8AB OF THE ACT.

14B. (1) A summons under section 8AA or 8AB of the Act shall specify the place at which the person summoned is required to appear before the Board. Proceedings under section 8AA or 8AB of the Act.

(2) The person summoned may appear either personally or by counsel.”
