REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1918.

## AUSTRALIAN MILITARY REGULATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1916, No. 166, as amended to this date.)

### AMENDMENT.

A. Sub-regulation (3) of regulation 87 is amended by deleting the word "three" and substituting therefor the word "four".

B. Add new regulation next after regulation 30:—

"30A. Notwithstanding anything in these Regulations, a Quartermaster of the Permanent Military Forces holding commissioned rank, may when no combatant officer is present, exercise command as if his rank was the substantive rank of a combatant officer of the Military Forces".
