## 1925 No. 190.

REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACE 1903-1918.

THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advise of the Rederal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the Defencé Act 1903-1916, to some into operation forthwith.

- AMENDMENT.

  A. Sub-regulation (3) of regulation 87 is amended by deleting the word "three" and substituting therefor the word "four.".
  - B. Add now regulation next after regulation 30:-
  - "30. Notwithstanding anthing in these Regulations, a Quartermaster of the Persacets Military Ecroes holding commissioned rank, may whon no combatant officer is present, exceedse command as it his runk was the substantive rank of a combatant officer of the Military Forces".
