## 1925. No. 209.

REGULATIONS UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903-1918.

I. THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advise of the Federal Excentive Conneil, hereby make the following Regulations under the Defence Act 1003-1018 to eome-into aperation as from 1st March, 1926.

REGULATIONS FOR. CIVILIAN STAFF (OTHEN THAN GOVERNMENT FACTORIES) UNDER DEFENCE ACT, SLOTION. 63.

## Amendment.

Regulation 1.-Delete definition "officer" and insert in lieu thereof the following:-

"Officer' means a person who is employed in pursuance of subsections (1) and (2) of section 63 of the Act, in a permanent equacity in souncesion with the Department of Refence and who is spointed by the Governor-General, and shall include persons appointed by the Governor-General to be foremon in Government Munitons Establishments."

Regulation 4.—After Regulation 4 (3) insert new sub-regulation (4):-

"(4) The hours of attendance of forement employ <sup>1</sup> in Government Munitions Establishments shall be 48 por week and shall be worked on six doys per week, Monday to Saturday inclusive—eight and three-quarter hours on Saturday—such hours to be worked between the hours of 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Moudays to Fridays inclusive, and 7 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Provided that, if necessary, there may he shift work, and in such cases the hours for any one shift shall not exceed eight and threequarter hours.

Provided further that the Minister may fix less than 48 hours as a week's work."

Regulation 82A --- After Regulation 82 insert new Regulations 82A and 828 :--

"82a. The number of persons appointed by the Governor-Goneral to be foremen in the Government Munitions Establishments shall not exceed fifteen, provided that the Minister may employ persons in excess of such number to be tomporary foremen.

82a. To be eligible for appointment os foreman in a Government Munitiona Establishment, a porson shall havo been employed for not less than ten years in a Government Establishment, fivo years of which must havo been in the position of temporary foreman in a Government Munifions Establishment, and shall possess such technical and éducational qualifications ns may be prescribed by the Minister.

82c. The rates of salary or weges to be paid to foremen and temporary foremon shell be os fixed by the Minister.

820. All temporary foremen shall be engaged temporarily by the day, and their engagements.shall be terminible without notice on either side, provided that a temporary foreman engaged under agreement shall be subject to the terms of such agreement. Employment as a tomporary foreman shall not establish any claim to permutent employment on any ground whatevest.

82E. With the exception of Regulations 51 and 52a, the word 'efficer' shall be read to include temporary foremen."
