

MATERNITY ALLOWANCE.

No. 34 of 1927.

An Act to amend the *Maternity Allowance Act*
1912-1926.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1927.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows :—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Maternity Allowance Act* 1927. Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *Maternity Allowance Act* 1912-1926* is in this Act referred
to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as
the *Maternity Allowance Act* 1912-1927.

2. Section six of the Principal Act is amended by inserting at the
end of sub-section (2.) the following proviso :— Who may be
claimants.

“ Provided that a woman who is an alien by reason of her
marriage to an alien shall not, in consequence only of her
alienage, be subject to the disqualification contained in this
sub-section.”
