"Conditions of special leave for employees of Munitions Supply

53a. Employees employed in the Munitions Establishments who are reported by the Commonwealth Medical Officer to need resuporative treatment owing to gaueral debility arising out of contact on duty with toxic substances employed in connexion with the production or use of nunitions may be granted by the Minister special leave of absence."
