REGULATION UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT
1901-1923,

AMENDMENT OF THE TELEGRAPH REGULATIONS.

After Telegraph Regulation 79 the following regulation is
inserted:—

79A. Stamp duty under the law of any State shall not be payable on any receipt given in connexion with any transaction under these Regulations. Stamp duty on receipts.
