## JURY EXEMPTION.

## No. 59 of 1932.

An Act to amend the Jury Exemption Act 1905-1922.

[Assented to 5th December, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Jury Exemption Act 1932.

  (2.) The Jury Exemption Act 1905-1922\*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Jury Exemption Act 1905-1932.
- 2. After section two of the Jury Exemption Act 1905-1922 the following section is added: —

Application of Act to Territories. "3.—(1.) Notwithstanding anything contained in the last preceding section, an officer of the Public Service of the Commonwealth shall not be exempt from serving as a juror in any Territory forming part of the Commonwealth, when summoned so to serve under the law of the Commonwealth or of such Territory, unless he is a person exempted under this section from so serving.

"(2.) For the purposes of the last preceding sub-section, the Governor-General may make regulations exempting from serving as jurors such persons or persons holding such offices or classes of offices as are specified in the regulations.".
