
JUDICIARY.

No. 65 of 1933.

An Act to amend section four of the *Judiciary Act* 1903-1932.

[Assented to 15th December, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Judiciary Act* 1933.

Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *Judiciary Act* 1903-1932,* as amended by the *Seat of
Government Supreme Court Act* 1933,† is in this Act referred to as
the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited
as the *Judiciary Act* 1903-1933.

2. Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the
word "six" and inserting in its stead the word "five".
