REGULATIONS UNDER THE WHEAT GROWERS RELIEF ACT 1933.

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, asing with the advice of the Federal Excentive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the Wheat Growers Belief Act 1983.

WHEAT GROWERS RELIEF REGULATIONS.

1. These Regulations may be eited as the Wheat Growere Relief Short title. Regulations.

2. All Regulations made under the Act and in force at the Report. commencement of these Regulations are hereby repealed.

3.-(1.) In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention Detaitions. appears-

"assistance" means assistance provided under the Act;

" the Act " means the Wheat Growers Relief Act 1933."

(2.) In these Regulations any reference to a Form shall be read as a reference to a Form contained in the Schedule to these Regulations.

4. A wheat-grower who desires to claim assistance shall lodge, in <u>Declaration to</u> duplicate, with the State Authority for the State in which its resides be what grown (or with the Secretary, Department of Commerce, Caubern, in the corrected case of what growers resident in any Territory) a declaration in ^{form}.

5. A wheat-grower in a Territory who desires to claim assistance claims for shall forward to the Secretary, Department of Commerce, Canberra, on maintance by or before the thirtieth day of June, 1934, in addition to the declaration as Territory referred to in the last preceding regulation, a claim for assistance, and a declaration, in secondance with Form B;

6. All deplarations made under or in pursuance of these Regulations Persons below woon all be made before shall be made before--

(a) a Commissioner for Declarations,

(b) a Justice of the Peace, (c) a Bank Manager,

(d) a Postmaster or officer in charge of a Post Office.
