REGULATIONS UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH AOT 1901-1934 AND THE WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY AOT 1905-1939.\*

## AMENDMENTS OF THE GENERAL REGULATIONS.

- 1. The heading to the General Regulations, namely, "General Heading. Regulations" is omitted and the heading "Postal and Telegraphic Services (General) Regulations" inserted in its stead.
- Regulation I of the General Regulations is amended by omitting spectures, the words "General Regulations" and inserting in their stead the words "Postal and Telegraphic Services (General) Regulations".
- 3. Regulation 2 of the Postal and Telegraphie Services (General) Information not Regulations is amended by omitting the words "Deputy Postmaster-General" and inserting in their stead the words "Deputy Director, Posts and Telegraphs."
- 4. Regulation 5 of the Postal and Telegraphie Services (General) Production of Regulations is amended by omitting the words "Deputy Postmaster documents." (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "Deputy Director, Posts and Telegraphs".
- 5. Regulation 6 of the Postal and Telegraphic Services (General) Stampdaty not Regulations is amended by omitting the words "Postal, Telegraph, rectipus. Telephone, or Wireless Regulations" and inserting in their stend the words "Postal Regulations, the Telegraph Regulations, the Telephone Regulations, or the Wireless Telegraphy Regulations.
