## SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION 1937-38.

**No. 41 of 1939.**

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight.

[Assented to 27th September, 1939.]

[Date of commencement 25th October, 1939.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Act* 1937-38. Short title.

**2.** The sum of Nine hundred and three thousand eight hundred and ninety-two pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the commencement of the *Appropriation Act* 1937-38 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act. Appropriation of £903,892.
