OFFICERS' RIGHTS DECLARATION.

No. 86 of 1940.

An Act to amend the Officers' Rights Declaration Act 1928-1933.

[Assented to 16th December, 1940.] [Date of commencement, 13th January, 1941.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :-

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Officers' Rights Declaration Short title Act 1940.

- (2.) The Officers' Rights Declaration Act 1928-1933* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Officers' Rights Declaration Act 1928–1940.
- 2. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by inserting Application after the word "Schedule" the words "to this Act or by regulations of Act. made under an Act and Section specified in that Schedule".
- 3. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in Rights sub-section (1.) after the word "Schedule" the words "to this Act preserved or retained. or by regulations made under any of the Acts and Sections specified in that Schedule".

4. Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from Officer to be sub-section (3.) the words "appointment to an office in the Public unattached during Service of such status and salary as are determined by the Public employment. Service Board of Commissioners" and inserting in their stead the words "be appointed by the Public Service Board to an office in the Public Service of such status and salary as are determined by the Board".

5. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended by inserting The Schedule. after the words "Commonwealth Bank Act 1911-1927, ss. 16A, 35Q.", the words "Commonwealth Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1904-1934, ss. 50A, 92.".
