AMENDMENT OF NATIONAL SECURITY (SUPPLEMENTARY) REGULATIONS.

Regulation 11 of the National Security (Supplementary) Regula- appointment to tions is amended by adding the following sub-regulation at the end of enlitment in thereof :-

"(6.) If, under the regulations relating to the entry of persons into any part of the Defence Force, naturalized British subjects are not cligible to be appointed or enlisted in that part, this regulation shall apply in relation to the appointment or enlistment of naturalized British subjects in that part as if they were aliens."
