

NATIONALITY (No. 2).

No. 28 of 1946.

An Act relating to the Naturalization of Persons
who reside or have resided in the Territory
of New Guinea.

[Assented to 13th August, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Nationality Act (No. 2)* Short title
and citation.
1946.

(2.) Section one of the *Nationality Act* 1946* is amended by
omitting sub-section (2.).

(3.) The *Nationality Act* 1920–1936†, as amended by the *Nationality*
Act 1946 and by this Act, may be cited as the *Nationality Act*
1920–1946.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it Commencement.
receives the Royal Assent.

3. After section five A of the *Nationality Act* 1920–1936, as
amended by the *Nationality Act* 1946, the following section is inserted
in Part I. :—

“5B.—(1.) This Act shall extend to the Territory of New Guinea. Extension of
Act to New
Guinea.

“(2.) Any reference in sections seven and twelve of this Act to
His Majesty's dominions and in section twenty-five of this Act to
the British Empire shall be deemed to include a reference to the
Territory of New Guinea.”.
