CENSUS AND STATISTICS.

No. 74 of 1946.

An Act to amend the Census and Statistics Act 1905-1938.

[Assented to 14th December, 1946.] [Date of commencement, 11th January, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Census and Statistics Act 1946.

- (2.) The Census and Statistics Act 1905-1938*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Census and Statistics Act 1905-1946.
- 2. Section twelve of the Census and Statistics Act 1905-1938 is Particulare to amended—
 - (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) the words "sickness or infirmity,"; and
 - (b) by omitting from that paragraph the word ", education,".
