

CENSUS AND STATISTICS.

No. 74 of 1946.

An Act to amend the *Census and Statistics Act*
1905-1938.

[Assented to 14th December, 1946.]

[Date of commencement, 11th January, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows :—

Short title
and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Census and Statistics Act*
1946.

(2.) The *Census and Statistics Act* 1905–1938*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Census and Statistics Act* 1905–1946.

2. Section twelve of the *Census and Statistics Act* 1905–1938 is amended— Particulars to
schedule.

(a) by omitting from paragraph (a) the words “sickness or infirmity,”; and

(b) by omitting from that paragraph the word “, education,”.
