An Act to amend the Spirits Act 1906-1935.

[Date of commencement, 8th January, 1948.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Spirits Act 1947.

Short title and citation.

- (2.) The Spirits Act 1906-1935*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Spirits Act 1906-1947.
- 2. Section three of the Spirits Act 1906-1935 is amended by Interpretation. omitting from the definition of "Medicines" the words "and such liniments" and inserting in their stead the words", liniments and medicines for external application".
