AMENDMENTS OF THE FINANCIAL (MILITARY) REGULATIONS.

- 1. Regulation 3 of the Financial (Military) Regulations is amended Parts. by inserting, after the words "Part I.-Preliminary", the words "Part IA.—Pay of the Chief of the General Staff.".

- "(2.) The subdivision of the table contained in sub-regulation (1.) of this regulations applicable at the date of the commencement of these Regulations shall be determined by the Minister.
- "(3.) Regulations 12 to 20 inclusive and 36 and 37 of these Regulations shall not apply to or in respect of any officer who holds the appointment of the Chief of the General Staff.".
