AMENDMENTS OF BLACK MARKETING REGULATIONS.†

- 1. Regulation 2 of the Black Marketing Regulations is amended by Dectaration of omitting the word "retain" and inserting in its stead the word "have". possession of licences, &c., to be black Marketing Regulations are amended by adding at the marketing.
- end thereof the following regulation:-
- "4. It is hereby declared to be black marketing for any person, Declaration of in contravention of regulation 51 of the National Security (Liquid contraventions. Fuel) Regulations-
 - (a) to alter or deface any ration ticket or licence or any addition to or endorsement on a ration ticket or licence;
 - (b) to have in his possession any counterfeit or forged or altered ration ticket or licence.".
