- (f) by omitting from sub-regulation (5.) the words and figures "Four pounds per annum in the case of adult females and Three pounds per annum in the case of officers under 21 years of age" and inserting in their stead the words and figures "Four pounds per annum in the case of adult females and officers 19 and 20 years of age and Three pounds per annum in the case of officers under 19 years of age";
- (g) by omitting from sub-regulation (6.) all the words and figures from and including the words "Adult males" to the end of the sub-regulation and inserting in their stead the words and figures:—
