(2.) Paragraph (e) of regulation 1 of these Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the fourteenth day of July, 1949.

(3.) Paragraph (b) of regulation 1 of these Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the twenty-second day of August, 1949.
