AMENDMENTS OF THE ALIENS REGULATIONS.

- 1. Regulation 5 of the Aliens Regulations is amended by omitting Registration of paragraph (a) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

 Australia.
 - "(a) An application for registration in a form approved by the Minister;".
- 2. Regulation 17 of the Aliens Regulations is amended by omitting Master to sub-regulation (2.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-supply information regulation:—

"(2.) The furnishing of a list of outgoing passengers by the master outgoing of a vessel in accordance with the Navigation Act 1912-1942 or by the master of an aircraft in accordance with the Census and Statistics Act 1905-1949 shall be deemed to be a sufficient compliance with the last preceding sub-regulation."
