REGULATION UNDER THE DAIRY PRODUCE EXPORT CHARGES ACT 1924-1937.*

AMENDMENT OF THE DAIRY PRODUCE EXPORT CHARGES REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 4 of the Dairy Produce Export Charges Regulations is repealed and the following Regulation inserted in its stead:—

“4. The officer to whom moneys payable under section 3 of the *Dairy Produce Export Charges Act 1924-1937* shall be paid, is the officer holding or occupying in a State the office specified in the following table in respect of that State:—

State.	Designation of Office.
New South Wales ..	Collector of Public Moneys, Department of Commerce and Agriculture, Sydney.
Victoria ..	Collector of Public Moneys, Department of Commerce and Agriculture, Melbourne.
Queensland ..	Collector of Public Moneys, Department of Commerce and Agriculture, Brisbane.
South Australia ..	Collector of Public Moneys, Department of Commerce and Agriculture, Adelaide.
Western Australia ..	Collector of Public Moneys, Department of Commerce and Agriculture, Perth.
Tasmania ..	Collector of Customs, Hobart. ”.
