EXCISE TARIFF VALIDATION.

No. 65 of 1953.

An Act to provide for the Validation of Collections of Duties of Excise under Excise Tariff Proposals.

[Assented to 28th October, 1953.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Excise Tariff Validation Act Short title. 1953.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement. receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. All duties of Excise demanded or collected (whether before or validation of after the commencement of this Act and on or before the fifth under Excise day of December, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-three)

 Tariff Proposals. pursuant to Excise Tariff Proposals No. 5 introduced into the House of Representatives on the ninth day of September, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, shall be deemed to have been lawfully imposed and lawfully demanded or collected.
